FAREWELL, MAUREEN O'HARA

Maureen O'Hara will be remembered by many as a Hollywood legend and proud Irishwoman. Here in Long Island City, she is also known as a long-time friend and honorary member of the County Cork B.P.&P. Association, and, for that, we are forever grateful.

Born Maureen FitzSimons on August 17, 1920, in Ranelagh, on the outskirts of Dublin, she was the second of six children. Ms. O'Hara began appearing in school plays as a child and was accepted as a student at the Abbey Theater in Dublin when she was 14. A screen test in 1938 helped launch a career in movies that spanned from 1939 until her last screen appearance in 2000.

Past President Joe Murphy, a very close friend of Maureen, was instrumental in inviting her to be the Association's Guest of Honor at the annual St. Patrick's Banquet in 1985. Several years later, Maureen accepted the honor again at the 1997 Biennial Dinner Dance held in Ireland. In fact, she attended many Cork Dinners and even installed our Officers on a few occasions.

In 1999, Maureen served as the Grand Marshal of the New York City St. Patrick's Day Parade. The County Cork B.P.&P. Association contingent proudly marched up 5th Avenue.

Maureen was always welcome at the Cork Hall. One evening she shared the stage with An Taoiseach Jack Lynch (RIP) and together they entertained all those gathered with songs and stories. Jack Lynch sang The Banks of My Own Lovely Lee that night and Maureen sang the Isle of Innisfree. Every single person who had the honor of spending time in her company recalls her humor, her graciousness and her indomitable Irish spirit.

Maureen O'Hara passed away at the age of 95 on October 24th, and is survived by her daughter, a grandson and two great-grandchildren.

Many will remember her as a glamorous and talented actress, but the County Cork Association is honored to be able to call her our very dear friend. Slán abhaile a Mhairín! Slán abhaile!
