The Westchester County AOH held their 1916 Easter Rising Centennial and Annual Dinner Dance in Tarrytown on April 16th. Honorees included celebrated author Tim Pat Coogan and the U.S. Ambassador Thomas Foley. A great evening was had by all in attendance, including President Deirdre O'Hea and Past Presidents Mae O'Driscoll and Dan Dennehy.

On Saturday, April 23rd, a commemoration Mass was held at St. Patrick's Cathedral, followed by a flag-raising on the plaza of the Irish Consulate.

On Sunday, April 24th, the Cork contingent were on hand to support the United Irish Counties at Antun's as they launched <u>The 1916 Easter Rising: New York and Beyond</u>, their book of essays commemorating the Irish and Irish Americans who took part in The Rising.
