A MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT TREASA GOODWIN-SMYTH

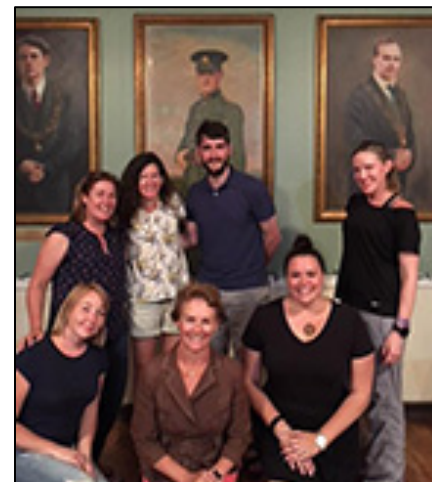
I hope you all are having a wonderful summer. Congratulations to all our Members and their Children on graduating recently. We wish them continued success whether it be to High School College or in their new career.

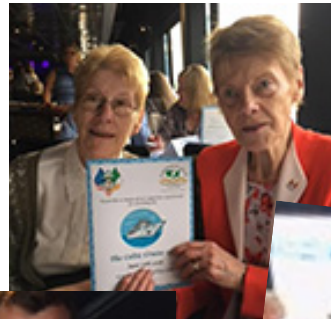
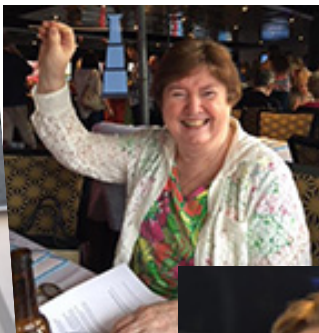
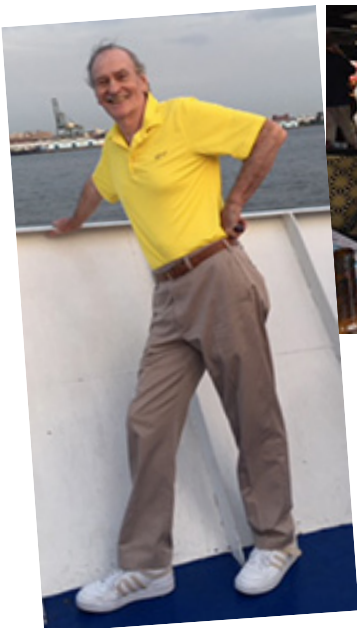


GOOD NEWS:

This year we are delighted to honor two outstanding Corkonians – **Dolores Casey** our esteemed member and Inniscara native and **Niall Cahalane**, Castlehaven native and renowned member of the Cork Senior Football Team (1984-1997) and is considered one of the greatest players of his time.

Dolores Casey, the eldest of five siblings born to Bill and Siobhan Casey of Inniscarra. Dolores was educated at Cloghroe National School, Miss O'Sullivan's School in Cork City and received her third level education at the Lee College in Cork. After graduation she was employed by Shanakiel Hospital where she worked for many years. In 1991 she immigrated to New York being the lucky recipient of a Morrison Visa. With her move to New York, a career change was in store for Dolores – a career in the legal field. She is currently employed by the great firm of McCabe, Collins, McGeough, Fowler, Levine & Nogan, LLP in Carle Place, Long Island. Dolores is an active participant in the Irish American community, she is a proud member of the Co. Cork Association, a member of the Irish American Society of Nassau, Suffolk and Queens where she is Chairperson of the Board of Trustees and Assistant Financial Secretary. She is also Secretary of the Mulligan Quinn Branch of Comhaltas and a member of the Cill Cais Players drama group. Dolores is a resident of Mineola, Long Island.

Niall Cahalane, the eldest of ten siblings was born in Castlehaven, West Cork to John and Maureen Cahalane in 1963. He was educated at the local National School in Castlehaven and attended St. Fachtna's De La Salle Secondary school in Skibbereen. His interest in football began at a very early age, first playing for his native Castlehaven Football Club at the age of seven in 1970. Niall continued to play with Castlehaven for the U14, U16, Minor U21 and Senior Football from 1970 until his retirement in 2004. During his illustrious football career Niall wearing the Cork Jersey won 2 Senior All Ireland Championship Medals in 1989 and '90 that same year Cork won the Double in Football and Hurling. He won many underage medals for West Cork and County, also winning 9 Munster Senior Medals, and 2 All Stars 1987 and 1989. Niall worked in New York in the construction industry during 1982, 1983 and 1984. In Cork he has worked as an auctioneer for the past thirty years and is a partner in the firm of Cahalane Skuse Auctioneers & Valuers. Niall is married to the former Ailish Cleary and they have seven children – three sons and four daughters.
