COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

RULES AND REGULATIONS

AWARDS -The awards will consist of scholarships ranging between \$1,000 - \$2,500. Awards may be used for tuition only and will be paid directly to the college or accredited institute of higher knowledge at which the awardee is accepted.

ELIGIBILITY - The Scholarships are open to members in good standing as of November 1, 2019 and to the children of members in good standing graduating high school in 2019

The applicant **must have completed high school and must submit SAT scores for 2019 and an essay in order to qualify for scholarship.**

ESSAY RULES - The subject of the essay will be: **The Burning of Cork City in 1920** The essay must be at least 1,000 words and must be typewritten and double spaced on 8-1/2 x 11 paper. The title must be placed at the top of the paper. Entrant's name or any other identifying marks will not appear on the essay paper. A bibliography of sources for the essay material must be attached to the essay. Each essay must be the sole work of the entrant. All essays received become the property of the Association and may be printed in the future using the contestant's name.

JUDGING - The judges will be selected annually by the Scholarship Committee. They will be comprised of scholars and leaders in the community who are not members of the Association. The decision of the judges will be final. The decision will be made, judged on style, organization and content.

DISQUALIFICATION - Entrants must comply with all the rules regarding the scholarship competition or be subject to disqualification. Disqualification will be made only by the majority vote of the Scholarship Committee and will be final and binding. Any information supplied by entrants found to be untrue will result in disqualification.

APPLICATION - Fully completed application forms and a copy of the applicant's SAT scores must accompany all essays. All applications must be sent by U.S. mail to Kathy McCarthy, 10 Lenox Road, Apt. 2-H, Rockville Centre, NY. 11570, or by email to mcleen16@aol.com, and must be received no later than midnight, January 2, 2020. (Email correspondence preferred)

The words "Scholarship Committee" must be written in the lower left hand corner of the envelope used to send all entries. Receipt of entries will be acknowledged only if a self-addressed, stamped envelope is enclosed.
