Rebels Power Past Waterford to Book Spot in Munster Final

It was a slow-burning start at SuperValu Páirc Uí Chaoimh on Sunday last, but the Rebels eventually found their rhythm and knocked Waterford out of the Munster Senior Hurling Championship with a 2-25 to 1-22 victory.

Cork initially struggled against a strong wind, falling four points behind by the 11-minute mark. But the home side gathered momentum late in the first half and came out firing in the second, landing two crucial goals to take control of the game.

Despite a valiant effort from the Déise, they couldn't claw their way back into contention before the final whistle—after four minutes of added time.

With the win, Cork advance to the Munster final, while Waterford's summer campaign comes to an end.



Munster Final Showdown Confirmed: Cork to Face Limerick

It's official—Cork will take on Limerick in the Munster Senior Hurling Championship Final.

The decider is set for Saturday, June 7th at 6pm and will be held at TUS Gaelic Grounds, Limerick.

After a hard-fought win over Waterford, the Rebels will now face the reigning Munster champions on their home turf in what promises to be a blockbuster clash. With silverware and bragging rights on the line, fans can expect fireworks.


